Ethics & Performance

The 2018 World's Most Ethical Companies have again proven that operating with integrity leads to greater financial performance. Research finds that, when indexed, listed World's Most Ethical Companies outperformed the U.S. Large Cap Index over five years by 10.72 percent and over three years by 4.88 percent. Ethisphere refers to this as the *Ethics Premium*.

Methodology & Scoring

The World's Most Ethical Companies assessment is based upon the Ethisphere Institute's Ethics Quotient[®] (EQ) framework, which offers a quantitative way to assess a company's performance in an objective, consistent and standardized manner. The information collected provides a comprehensive sampling of definitive criteria of core competencies rather than all aspects of corporate governance, risk, sustainability, compliance and ethics. Scores are generated in five key categories: ethics and compliance program (35 percent), corporate citizenship and responsibility (20 percent), culture of ethics (20 percent), governance (15 percent) and leadership, innovation and reputation (10 percent). All companies that participate in the assessment process receive their scores, providing them with valuable insights into how they stack up against leading organizations.

Republic continues to steadily build upon its industry-leading sustainability platform while earning notable recognition for sustainability and corporate responsibility achievements, as demonstrated by being named to the *Forbes* <u>America's Best Large Employers</u> list and inclusion in both the <u>Dow Jones</u> <u>Sustainability – North America and World – Indices</u>. Republic was also awarded the Gold Class Award in the <u>2018 RobecoSAM's Sustainability</u> <u>Yearbook</u> and earned the Carbon Disclosure Project's (CDP) Global Climate Management Level and the <u>Supplier Climate Management Level</u> distinctions. In addition, Glassdoor honored the Company with the <u>Employees' Choice Award</u>, based on anonymous and voluntary employee reviews.
